The Fondazione Willy Brandt (FWB) is an Italian Moral Institution recognized by Decree of the Ministry of Interior on 4th of August 2000. Foundation operates for the improvement of international relations and cooperation among people and intend to pursue and develop ideals of socio-cultural integration, welfare and the dissemination of ethical values, humanitarian solidarity and promoting peaceful coexistence between people, integration between cultures, local development, the spread of prosperity and economic cooperation in safeguarding the environment as a common resource.

The FWB pursue the statutory objectives by engaging in activities:

- cooperation, training and research in the field of environment with particular attention to sustainable development, alternative energy, reducing emissions of gases, technologies for energy, good practice in managing the cycle of urban and industrial waste, recovery and rehabilitation of contaminated zones;
- development of initiatives in the countries of South Eastern Europe to facilitate the path of adjustment to EU standards on the environment, to establish the management of immigration flows in Europe labour market, and to manage programs and initiatives for the promotion and protection of the environment;
- Development and implementation of environmental cooperation activities in areas of the Middle East and Brasile with the involvement and partnership of institutions, academic consortium or local and Italian entrepreneurial associations.

The FWB works within a network that involves the international cooperation of Universities and Research Centers, Public Administrations, Businesses and Associations that support the objectives and actions.
