Dr. David Newman is the General Director of **CIC (Italian Composters Consortium)**.

Board Member of the **International Solid Waste Association (ISWA)**.

Member of Scientific Committee of **Ecomondo** (International Fair of Material & Energy Recovery and Sustainable Development).

Mr Newman collaborates with numerous Italian and foreign institutions for the implementation of programs and projects for separate collection of waste.

Consultant of the Umbria region for the drafting of the Regional Waste Plan.

He is one of the leading experts in the international field on biological treatment and recovery of organic waste through composting processes and use of compost as fertilizer for use in agriculture.

He is also author of numerous publications and scientific articles on the techniques of composting.

International lecturer and presenter of numerous projects on the reduction, recycling and recovery of waste.

Under his direction, the CIC has achieved excellent results, bringing the total of supporters to little bit less than 120 companies, including public and private, and about 230 small and large composting plants.

In 2007, among kitchen, canteen and green waste from the maintenance of gardens, supporters of the CIC were collected and processed about 3 million tons of biomass converted into compost, and has yielded about 200 million euros .
